6. Who benefited from the movement's success?
7. Did the movement dehumanize or objectify anyone?
8. Did it support nonviolence and democracy?
9. Was the movement honest and open about its goals?
10. What would the world look like if the movement achieved its goals? Would anyone be harmed if this movement achieved its goals?
