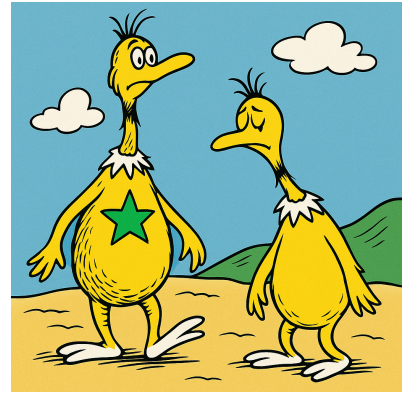


Student Worksheet #1: Questions on The Sneetches, by Dr. Seuss (6 Questions)

6. What lesson do YOU think the Sneetches teach about prejudice and kindness?
