

Student Worksheet #1: Red Flag Checklist:

10 Crucial Questions to Analyze a Social Justice Movement

Questions:

1. Does this movement allow people to ask questions - or punish dissent?
2. Does it rely on fear, shame, or censorship to spread its message?
3. Does it present one side as 100% good and the other as evil?
4. Does it respect freedom of speech - or label disagreement as hate?
5. Does it teach people to think — or to obey without questioning?
6. Does it unite through truth — or divide through emotion and blame?

7. Does it acknowledge uncomfortable facts — or rewrite or ignore them?

8. Are people forced to support it to feel safe or included?

9. Is disagreement discussed respectfully — or punished or censored?

10. Would this movement survive open debate and truth — or does it need to hide it?
